Wadadli Winter Barbecue - Set Menu

£45pp - £55pp (late dance session)

Spiced pumpkin fritters (vg)
Smoked cheddar & jalapeno fritters

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Main courses are sharing dishes for minimum 2 people

Spit roast whole chicken, coconut tea

or

Barbecued whole fish (today's pick from the market) in banana leaf

or

Barbecued tomahawk steak, Arawak chimichurri (£10 supplement per person)

or

Wild mushroom & chestnut stuffed pumpkin, baked in the embers (vg)

served with

Barbecued carrots, pumpkin seed dukkah
Charred sweetheart cabbage, green chilli butter
Fried plantain
Scotch bonnet fries

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Pineapple upside down cake, rum syrup, cardamom & lime custard (vg option)

or

Chocolate and Salted Caramel shots
